- Look for networking opportunities

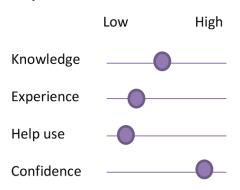
Ideal features

- Renew membership

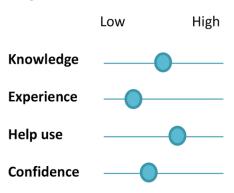
Ideal features

- Increase efficiency

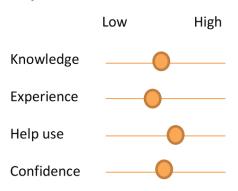
Ideal features
